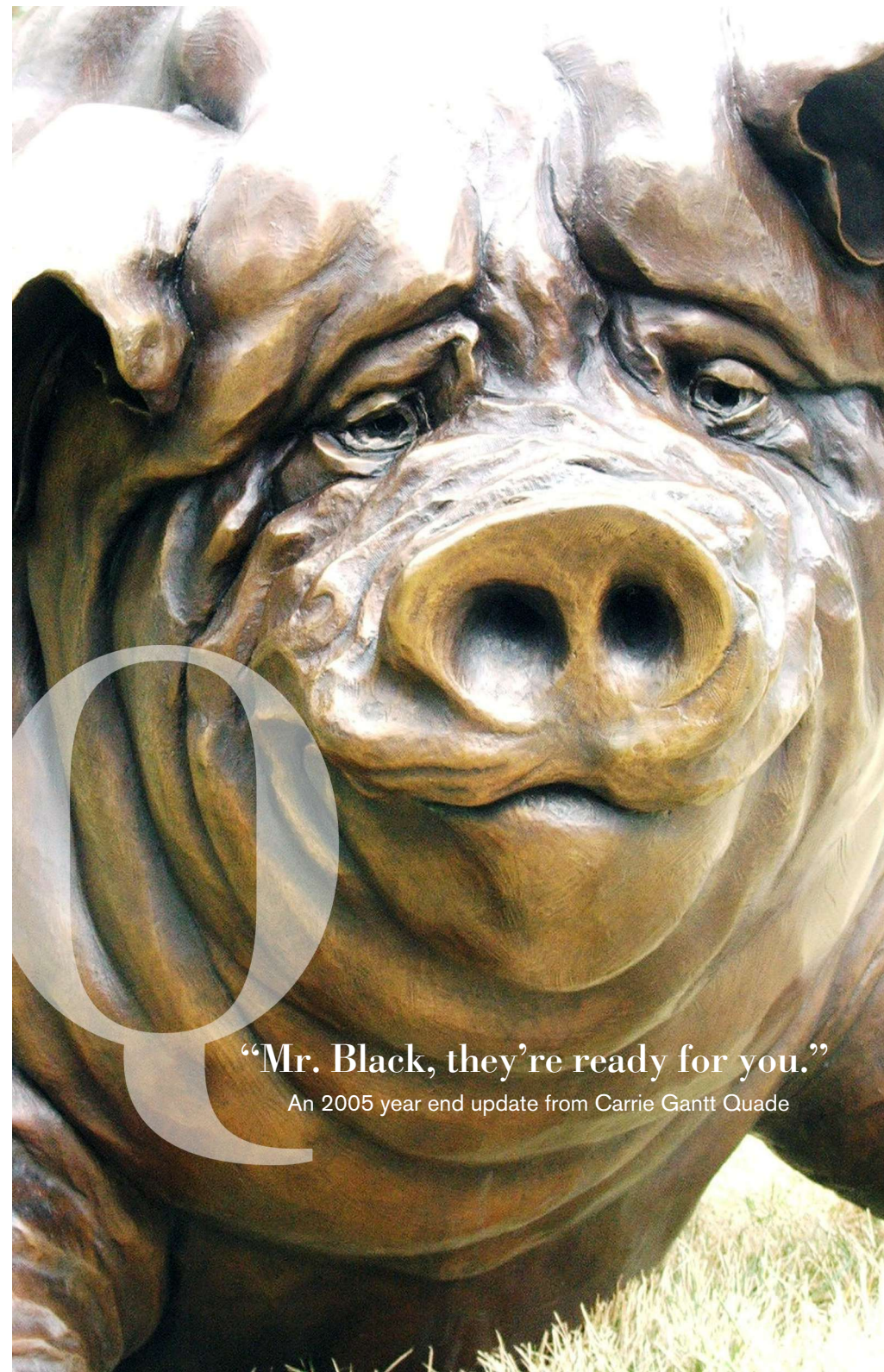

An 2005 year end update from Carrie Gantt Quade

In late January 2005, I moved to Santa Fe, NM, after many years of travel to the area. The landscape, the colors and art community were incredibly inspiring to me, and I knew I needed time to immerse myself in the southwest.



The temporary move was blessed from the start. Shortly after settling into my adobe home, I was accepted into The International Exhibition of Animals in Art. 777 entries from 44 states, Canada, Europe, Asia and Africa with only 75 accepted. Charlotte and Charlie Black, two of my pigs were selected. Both received judges awards, with Charlotte chosen to be on the cover of next year's catalog and invitations...I am so proud of both of them!

Now the most exciting news...acceptance into Sculpture in the Park, held in Loveland, Colorado. This show features the work of 180 professional artists, with over 25,000 visitors during the show. I feel extremely fortunate to be showing along side some of the top sculptors in the country! I was so excited that I decided to 'knock'em dead' with a 5 ft version of Charlie Black. He cannot be missed. The show was held August 13 & 14, at the Benson Sculpture Garden, Loveland, CO.

November 2005

Sculpture in the Park was a very successful show. Several of the new RED sculptures sold and I have been invited back without having to jury into the show. I received a note from the president of LHPAC encouraging me to submit a proposal for permanent placement of big Charlie Black in the Benson Sculpture Garden.

Another big Charlie Black now resides in Mesa, Arizona. 'Sculpture in the Streets' is a program that invites sculptors to submit outdoor works that line the streets of downtown Mesa. Some sculptures are selected for permanent installation. Also in the Scottsdale, Arizona area, I have a new gallery. Heritage Gallery will carry my work and will also be promoting my ceramic 'Saddle People'.

It has been a very exciting year and I am looking forward to many new pieces and adventures in the coming year. I truly thank all of you that have supported this growth through the years. Thank you, thank you.
